Dale Ahlquist

Dale Ahlquist is President of the American Chesterton Society and publisher of *Gilbert Magazine*. He is the author of three books on G. K. Chesterton, including *The Complete Thinker*, which was published in the fall of 2012, and has edited eight books of Chesterton's writings. He has given over 400 lectures at major colleges and universities and other venues, including Yale, Columbia, Cornell, Notre Dame, Oxford, Cal-Berkeley, Cal-Tech, Rice, Penn, Dartmouth, University of Colorado, Georgia, Iowa, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Seattle, Tulsa, and San Pablo, Madrid. He is a Senior Fellow of the Chesterton Library in Oxford.
