

The Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary



May 31st

How does this happen to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me? Luke 1:43

Mary had just discovered that she would bear God's Son. Yet instead of retreating in silence and solitude to contemplate this miraculous event, she set out on an arduous journey of eighty miles to visit her cousin Elizabeth.

Mary surely wanted to provide Elizabeth with practical help and support as her aging cousin awaited the birth of her own son, John the Baptist. But Mary also wanted to confide in Elizabeth her own wondrous news of the coming birth of the long-expected Messiah. She must have known that Elizabeth would greet this news with excitement and joy, not skepticism.

Mary's decision to spend time with Elizabeth was an act of human solidarity. It reflects a fundamental truth of the way God made us – as a community of people who share our joys and sorrows with one another.

Mary's actions also reflected Christ's presence in her. Instead of turning inward upon herself, she reached out to someone else. How incredibly beautiful that her first instinct was to visit her cousin! Yet isn't that always what Christ's presence within us does? It prompts us, like Mary, to reach out and love another person in some specific and inspired way. This is what it means to let Christ within us move us to love.
