Saturday 2:30-3:30pm in the church or by appointment.



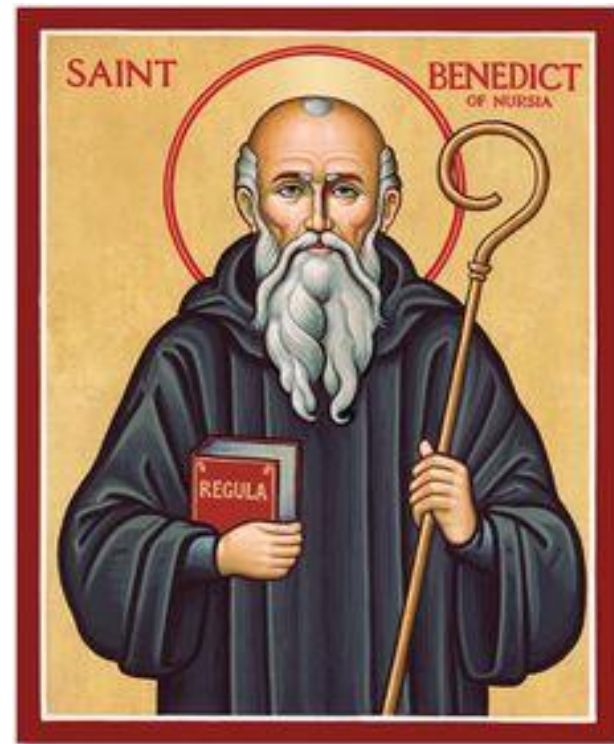

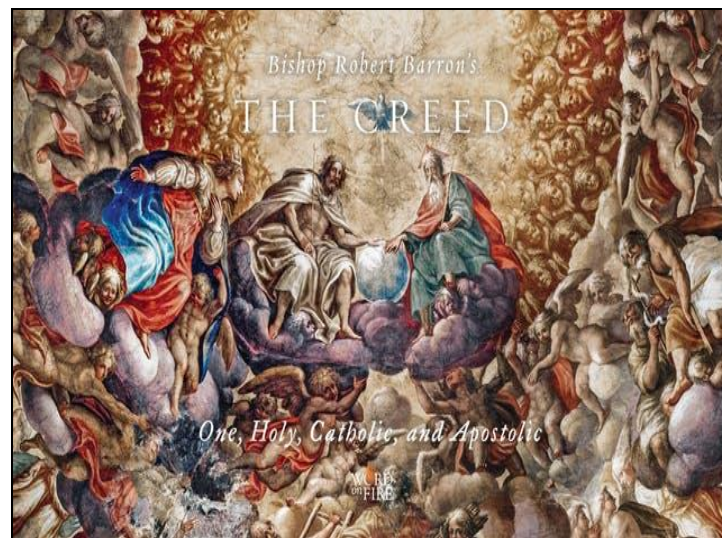
