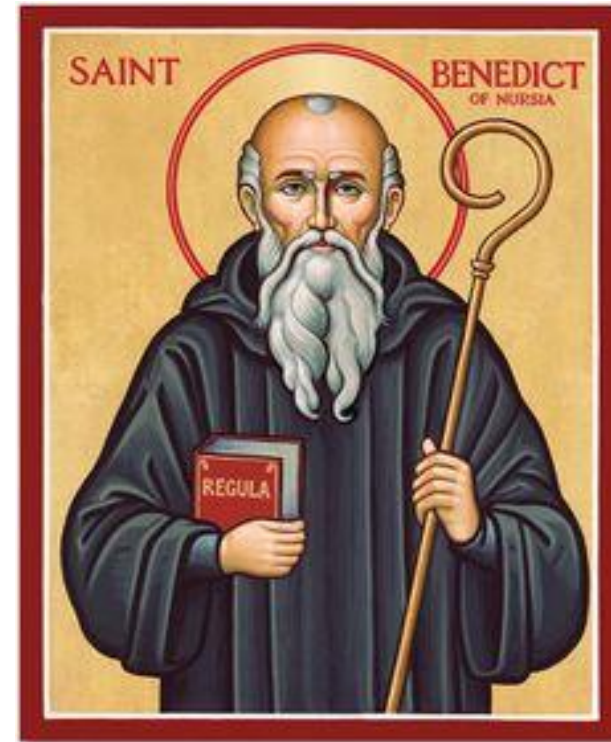
AMD Envelopes

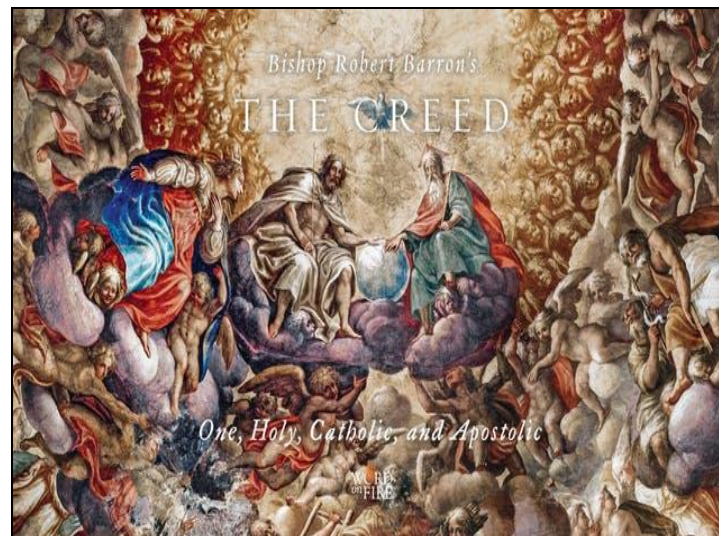
