In regards to fall sports, the CYO has decided not to sanction or offer their backing for any fall sports. They have put all of the decisions and responsibilities directly onto each school. As a school we are following strict guidelines in the building. We feel that it is counterproductive to play sports where contact was unavoidable, or where grade by grade separation was not practical because most of our sports are mixed. For the specific sports we are involved in as a school here is what we are doing.

CHEER will be delayed until the winter season. If there is a possibility of conditioning and skill training by grade level we will let you know.

VOLLEYBALL will be broken down to skill training and conditioning by grade level. We will be setting a schedule in the next week or so.

CROSS COUNTRY is the only sport right now that has no change. They are outside and able to distance themselves. We will re-evaluate once they decide how they will run meets.

FOOTBALL

We as a school can only recommend extra caution and awareness if you are an athlete participating in a travel or club sport. These are not sanctioned or controlled by Precious Blood or the CYO. Since CYO removed themselves from the fall seasons, and our football participation is with a group based at other locations it effectively became a club sport.
