The countries are assigned as follows:

PreK - Argentina (light blue, white)	K - Nicaragua (blue, white)
1st - Columbia (yellow, blue, red)	2nd - Venezuela (yellow, blue, red)
3rd - Honduras (light blue, white)	4th - El Salvador (blue, white)
5th - Costa Rica (red, white, blue)	6th - Guatemala (light blue, white)
7th - México (green, white, red)	8th - Ecuador (yellow, blue, red)
