

1. The metric of 30% of the fire capacity of the church has been determined. After calculation, the maximum number of persons permitted in our church at the same time is:

2. A system must be developed to limit access of the Mass attendance to 30% capacity:  
namely through:
  - a) Electronic or phone reservations prior to Mass
  - b) Alphabetically dividing parishioners
  - c) Pre-arranged ticket system
  - d) First come first serve
  - e) Other means: \_\_\_\_\_
3. Churches may open 30 minutes before each mass.
4. The doors can be left open if possible. If not, volunteers with gloves have to hold the door open for parishioners. Volunteers at the entrance door offering hand sanitizer. Parishioners must wear masks and practice proper hand hygiene.
5. If you have an elevator, there has to be a volunteer with mask and gloves at all times before and after mass. One person in elevator at a time. Cleaning of buttons after each usage.
6. Everyone has to wear a mask. If no mask, no one will be allowed to enter the church.
7. If someone does not feel well, that person must not, under any circumstances, attend the celebration of Mass.
8. Everyone must maintain 6 feet distance between each other (families of the same household can sit together) and avoid congregating before and after mass.
9. A secure container supervised by a volunteer should be placed in a prominent area so parishioners can deposit their offerings.
10. No holy water.
11. No procession
12. No books. No exchange of any material.
13. No children liturgy.
14. Washrooms to be used as per your discretion. To be used for emergencies only. If used, they need to be sanitized after each usage.

15. Parishioners must be instructed about these steps before the beginning of Mass.
16. Singers must be at a distance of at least 10 to 12 feet apart from each other and everyone.
17. It is not necessary to receive Holy Communion at Mass and one can legitimately remain in one's seat. No communion on the tongue is permitted. (Robert will have further information in his presentation.)
18. At the exit of the church, volunteers will hold the doors open for parishioners.
19. All pews and sitting areas has to be sanitized after each mass.
