### Celebrated Mass Intentions Distribution

Up to 3 intentions per celebration/mass (Policy No. 25 3.b.)

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Celebration/Mass

1<sup>st</sup> Intention-----Paid to celebrant  
2<sup>nd</sup> Intention -----Multiple Stipend  
3<sup>rd</sup> Intention-----Multiple Stipend

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Celebration /Mass

1<sup>st</sup> Intention-----Bination  
2<sup>nd</sup> Intention -----Multiple Stipend  
3<sup>rd</sup> Intention-----Multiple Stipend

Pro Populo masses which are celebrated do not include a stipend. Canon 534 states that the pastor is obligated to apply a Mass for the people entrusted to him on each Sunday and Holy Day of obligation. This means that the 1<sup>st</sup> Intention of the 1<sup>st</sup> Celebration would be the Pro Populo mass and no stipend would be paid to the celebrant on those days. That is why the pastor salary is higher than the associate salary. (see Appendix XI).

The Bination cheque is issued to the Diocese of Sault Ste. Marie.  
The Multiple stipend cheque is issued to the Clergy Benefit Fund.
