Motor Procession from Mount Olivet Cemetery to the Basilica

There will only be about 25 vehicles in the police escorted procession. However, other vehicles can follow and obey normal traffic laws. Here's the route we're taking to retrace the steps taken when they moved his body from downtown to the new cemetery grand opening in 1886: Drive out of the Mount Olivet Cemetery. Turn right onto Donaldson Road. Turn left onto Gleason Drive. Turn right onto Dunlap Ave. Make a quick left onto Gleason Drive. Turn right onto South Seminole Drive. Turn left to East Main Street. Turn right onto Market Street. Turn left onto East Eighth Street. Turn right into the All Saints parking lot. (Parking is also available at the UTC lot across from All Saints Academy.) Process on foot down to the Basilica.
