The Deacon's Corner
A Secret Weapon – Part 2

Last week we identified "The Secret Weapon" to be the Holy Rosary...and that is it!

Hopefully, these two articles will be an encouragement to pray the Holy Rosary more often. The Venerable Archbishop Fulton Sheen put it this way:

"If anyone wishes to convert anyone to the fullness of the knowledge of Our Lord and His Mystical Body, then teach him the Rosary. One of two things will happen. Either he will stop saying the Rosary – or he will get the gift of faith."

The Venerable Fulton Sheen was speaking to each one of us when he made that statement. I know, because he spoke to my heart.

After the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, the Holy Rosary is the prayer most pleasing to Our Blessed Mother. Reigning as Queen of Heaven and sitting next to the King, her beloved Son, Our Lady has been given the dispensation to grant God's graces to her spiritual children, us, for whom she constantly intercedes. She promised St. Dominic and all who follow that "Whatever you ask in the Rosary will be granted." She also revealed to him 15 promises to those who faithfully pray the Rosary. Here are those promises:

1. Whoever shall faithfully serve me by the recitation of the Rosary shall receive signal graces. [Single graces are simple signs from God in response to a question asked in prayer or a sign that you are moving in the right direction.]
2. I promise my special protection and greatest graces to all those who shall recite the Rosary.
3. The Rosary shall be a powerful armor against hell.
4. It will cause good works to flourish; it will obtain for souls the abundant mercy of God; it will withdraw the hearts of men from the love of the world and its vanities and will lift them to the desire of Eternal things. Oh, that souls would sanctify themselves by this means!

5. The soul which recommends itself to me by the recitation of the Rosary shall not perish.
6. Whoever shall recite the Rosary devoutly, applying himself to the consideration of its Sacred Mysteries, shall never be conquered by misfortune. God will not chastise him in His justice, he shall not perish by an unprovided death; if he be just he shall remain in the grace of God and become worthy of Eternal Life.
8. Whoever shall have a true devotion for the Rosary shall not die without the Sacraments of the Church.
9. Those who are faithful to recite the Rosary shall have during their life and at their death the Light of God and the plenitude of His Graces; at the moment of death they shall participate in the merits of the Saints in Paradise.
10. I shall deliver from purgatory those who have been devoted to the Rosary.
11. The faithful children of the Rosary shall merit a high degree of Glory in Heaven.
12. You shall obtain all you ask of me by recitation of the Rosary.
13. All those who propagate the Holy Rosary shall be aided by me in their necessities.
14. I have obtained from my Divine Son that all the advocates of the Rosary shall have for intercessors the entire Celestial Court during their life and at the hour of death .
15. All who recite the Rosary are my Sons, and brothers of my Only Son Jesus Christ.
16. Devotion to my Rosary is a great sign of predestination.
