- 250-word essay from the applicant giving the reasons for wanting to attend or continue attending Shrine Catholic Academy, written in the student's own handwriting.
- Letter from parent indicating the need for financial assistance.
- Parents must complete a FACTS Grant & Aid application to assist in the determination of financial need.

Submit completed scholarship application packet to the Admissions Office at Shrine Catholic High School & Academy, 3500 W. 13 Mile Road, Royal Oak, MI 48073. Once financial need is determined, the National Shrine Knights of Columbus Council will select the recipient on behalf of the Ward Family. Additionally, the National Shrine K of C Council is supporting the Ward Memorial Scholarship by awarding a \$250 scholarship to a second student based on the same criteria.
