



Shrine High School Detention Policy

- Detentions are held every Tuesday and Thursday in Room 205
Times: 7:00a.m. – 7:45a.m. **OR** 3:15p.m. – 4:00p.m.
- Students will be informed by the teacher issuing the detention and will receive notification from the Dean of Students.
- Students will be given one week to serve their detention, if not served, students will receive a 2nd detention.
- Students are not excused from detention for any reason. The student and family will need to make arrangements for the detention to be served on time.
- Students who miss detention are not allowed to participate in extra-curricular activities until the detention has been served. Sports practices are not a valid reason for missing detention. Coaches and moderators will be notified should a detention need to be served.
- Detention **will not** be used to do homework, sleep, socialize, use cell phones, or any other electronics.
- If a student misses a detention then he/she will serve a 2nd detention. If a student chooses not to serve either detention, the student will serve an in-school suspension.
- Students who receive 6 detentions for classroom behavior in a semester will meet with the Assistant Principal and parents will be notified.
- Students may speak to the Dean of Students ahead of the detention if the next detention cannot be served to find a new date. No guarantees will be granted to switch detention days. Students should attempt to change their detention date in a timely manner to increase the possibility of success.

A reminder to the parents and students: We have outlined all of our policies, procedures, and expectations in the handbook, which all students receive. This year, the administration and staff will strictly monitor cell phone use during school hours (7:53 am – 3:05 pm), which is not allowed. Parents may call the main office to leave messages for students. Parents should not send text messages to students during school hours. Thank you for your cooperation.
