## Annual Parent/Teacher Asbestos Notification 2021-2022

TO: Parents and Staff of Shrine Catholic High School and Academy

**Shrine Catholic High School and Academy** has had an Asbestos Management Plan prepared in compliance with the USEPA Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). This plan and subsequent updates are available for inspection Monday through Friday during normal school hours in the School Office.

In June, 2020, a three-year re-inspection, required by the AHERA regulation, was conducted by a Michigan Accredited Asbestos inspector to re-evaluate the condition of asbestos containing materials at the facility.

In December 30th, 2019, a Six-month Periodic Surveillance review, required by the AHERA regulation, was conducted by AKT Peerless Environmental Services to re-evaluate the condition of asbestos containing materials at the facility. In April, 2018, Marshall Dwyer performed a Six-month Periodic Surveillance reinspection.

Both inspections also evaluated Operations and Maintenance procedures that will keep asbestos materials in good condition.
