NATIONAL COLLECTION FOR THE TRINITY DOME

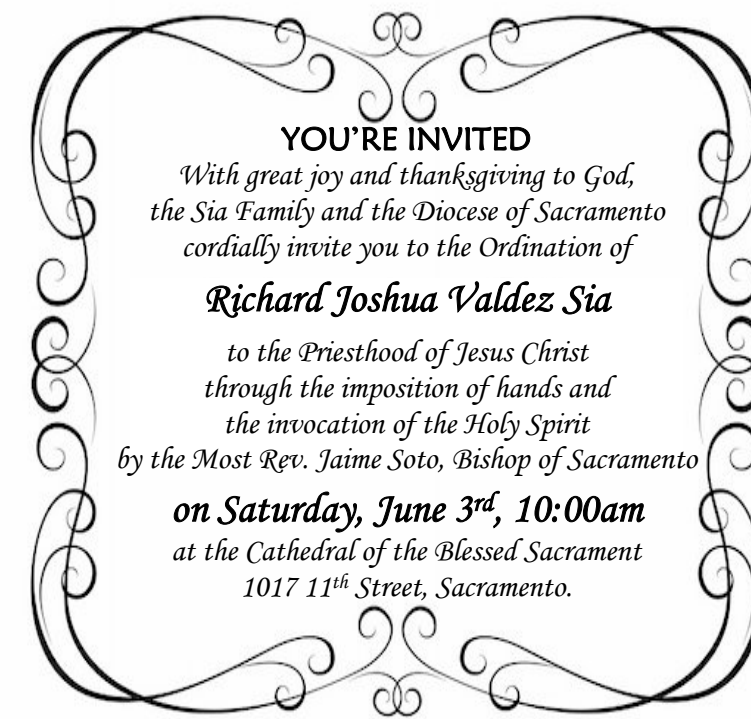
