



# St. Anne Catholic Grade School Dress Code

## **Young Ladies**

**Blouses:** A white, plain, oxford tailored long or short sleeve blouse, without any manufacturer's logo available at various local stores. Blouse must be tucked into uniform skirt or pants at all times.

**Polos:** (Optional) Green or White (St. Anne Crest Only) 7 & 8 th Grade Fridays only. Sold at the St. Anne Store (In the Religious Education office).

**Pants:** Solid navy slacks available at local stores. Supercords and Toughskins are allowed, but no slacks are to have contrasting stitching, rivets or denim. No cargo or carpenter pants are allowed. Slacks may be worn without the uniform jumper or skirt during the winter months as announced by the principal.

All are available through the Connie's Uniform Company <http://www.shopconnies.com>. You can shop online or at their store located in St. Clair Shores. All skirts are to be unrolled and not more than 1 inch above the knee.

**Shoes:** Dress shoes (leather, suede). No shoe is to be cut above the ankle. No tennis shoes, boots, sandals, backless shoes or canvas shoes of any kind. Heel is not to exceed 1 inch in height. Acceptable colors are brown, black or tan only. Parents can purchase school shoes at Michele's Children's Shoes at a discounted rate. Coupons are available in the office. **Socks:** Knee high or Tights only, Solid colors only: navy blue, white, hunter green & black. (no lace, logos, or characters).

**Make-up:** NO extreme hairstyles, NO hair coloring (dyed, bleached or highlighted) NO excessive jewelry (multiple earrings, thumb rings and/or chokers) or make-up of any kind are permitted. Clear nail polish only. No French nails or false nails or tips are to be worn. Post or small hoop earrings are acceptable.

**Hats:** Students are not allowed to wear hats, caps or other head coverings in the school building.

## **Young Men**

**Shirts:** A white oxford or dress shirt in either long or short sleeves without any manufacturer's logo. Golf, polo, or knit style shirts are not permitted. Shirts must be tucked into pants at all times.

**Polos:** (Optional) Green or White (St. Anne Crest Only) 7 & 8 th Grade Fridays only. Sold at the St. Anne Store (In the Religious Education office).

**Slacks:** Solid navy slacks available at local stores. Supercords and Toughskins are allowed, but no slacks are to have contrasting stitching, rivets or denim. No cargo or carpenter pants are allowed. Pants must be worn with a belt for 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th graders. No sagging pants are allowed.

**Sweaters:** Solid navy cardigan, crew neck, or v-neck sweaters are available through the Connies Uniform Company. No others are acceptable. Students may wear the grey sweatshirt with the St. Anne Crest. Other St. Anne sweatshirts or "hoodies" are not acceptable in class.

**Shoes:** Dress shoes (leather, suede). No shoe is to be cut above the ankle. No tennis shoes, boots, sandals, or canvas shoes of any kind. Acceptable colors are brown, black, Loafers, oxfords, or dress only. Parents can purchase school shoes at Michele's Children's Shoes at a discounted rate. Coupons are available in the office.

**Dress Socks:** Solid black or Navy No white socks. (no logo symbols).

**Hairstyles:** Boys' hair cuts must be above the collar and above the eyebrow. Half shaved styles, hair coloring, or any extreme hairstyles are not allowed. Boys are not allowed to wear earrings. Highlights are not acceptable.

**Hats:** Students are not allowed to wear hats, caps or other head covering in the school building.

**Ties:** 7th and 8th grade young men will be required to wear a navy blue tie on Monday-Thursday. Friday will be "spirit day" and the boys will not have to wear their ties and can wear their St. Anne jerseys over their oxford shirt.
