Dear Parents and Staff,

On Tuesday morning the asphalt company came out and began digging up the old parking lot nearest the church. As they finished one patch from Sycamore Street to our school their heavy machinery began sinking in the wet and soft soil. They had taken out over 8 inches of asphalt, most likely the original parking lot plus many other layers that were added over 75 years. They quickly realized that if they continued they would damage their equipment as the ground was so unstable.

There were a couple of options at that time and these have been brought to the Shea Foundation who will make the determination of how and when next to proceed. The area that had been dug up was patched over for the time being. We waited because there was a chance that they could still do the work before Sunday. At this time, however, because it would cost a considerable amount more to continue with the soil in the condition that they found it was in, it will most likely be completed in the summer months when they can remove all the asphalt, let the soil dry completely for a couple of weeks, and then redo the parking lot.

Today all of the classroom floors are being worked on as many of the tiles are broken, have holes in them, and needed repair. The faculty bathroom is also being fixed today and the water bottle fill up stations are being installed.
