## **Parish 'General Needs'**

Earnings from this fund support the parish where its needs are greatest.

For example, earnings might support general programs, building repairs, unexpected bills, and the many ministries serving our parishioners and the community.

## **Religious Formation and Youth Ministry**

Spiritual formation and sacramental preparation are at the heart of the Church's mission.

This fund supplies supplemental funding for PK – 12 religious education programs, youth ministry, college outreach to NDSCS, adult spiritual formation, retreats and RCIA—the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (those who are coming into the Church.)

## **Evangelization and Outreach**

There may be a particular ministry close to your heart. Perhaps it's music, liturgy, or outreach to the non-churched. Maybe it's serving the poor, the homebound, or imprisoned.

## **School 'General Needs'**

Earnings aid the school where needs are greatest.

It provides for new or unexpected expenses, is used to purchase supplementary curriculum materials, and helps offset the cost of updating technology.
