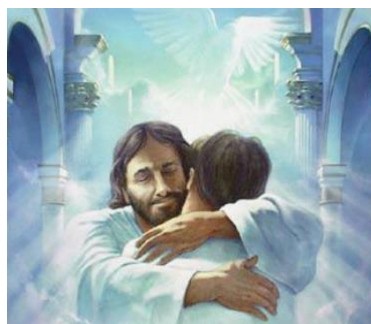

PRINCIPLES AND GUIDELINES FOR ATTENDING MASS AS WE GRADUALLY REOPEN OUR PARISH IN CONNELL

Dear Parishioners

We will begin Masses now inside the Church on Sundays on August 29th and 30th, 2020. In the initial process of reopening our parishes for Mass and other Sacramental celebrations, I have been asked by the State and the Diocese to draw up a plan and guidelines for us to follow at each church. The following plan and guidelines are based on what the State and Dioceses gave us. Please read through them, and I ask you to put them in practice especially when you come to church, for your own safety and the safety of all. Remember, if you feel sick, if you have even the slightest of symptoms, please, please, please; DO NOT COME TO MASS! I will continue to livestream the Masses on Facebook so you can follow it at home. Bishop Daly has continued the dispensation from the Sunday obligation to attend Mass.

Schedule of Masses:

ENGLISH MASS: Sundays at 10:30 am

SPANISH MASS: Saturdays at 4 pm and Sundays at Noon

What do I need to bring to church?

Please remember to wear a face mask if your health allows you to. If you do not have one and you need one, we will have face masks available at the church for free. Except for Holy Communion, please wear your mask throughout the Mass.

Seating arrangements at the church: Please sit 6-feet apart for each other or each other family. The ushers will assist.

NO singing at Mass for now.

There will not be Missals and hymn books. I encourage parishioners to bring their own personal missals to church.

SUNDAY COLLECTION: There will be no normal offering collection by the Ushers. Rather, we will place a basket by the altar for you to place your Sunday contribution as you come into the service or as you exit the service.

The sign of peace at mass will be omitted for now.

RECEIVING COMMUNION: Holy Communion will be distributed in the hands. There will not be receiving Communion from the Chalice. For communion, first the Choir Side of the pews will come forward to receive Holy Communion and then the Ambo Side of the pews will do so. Children who cannot receive Holy Communion will not come before the priest for the Blessing. They will have to stay seated in their pew.

BATHROOMS: I encourage you to please use the bathroom before leaving home. There will be no access to go inside the parish hall bathrooms. Remember to wash your hands before coming to Mass. Remember to keep your children with you and do not allow them to run around the church.

Finally, I know that the celebration of Mass is going to be different, and we may not be perfect in fulfilling all that we have been asked, but let's do our best, with the help of God. I am looking forward to celebrating Mass once again inside our Church with live people in front of me.
