St Stephen Catholic Church Groups and Ministries

Altar Care: This group is responsible for seeing that the sanctuary is appropriately decorated and adorned for all liturgical celebrations and seasons. They perform various services such as caring for the sacred vessels, altar linens, and other items used during the liturgy.

Bereavement: The Bereavement Ministry serves families who have lost a loved one to death. Its purpose is to provide comfort, support and encouragement to the deceased's family.

Knights of Columbus: The Knights of Columbus are a catholic fraternal organization dedicated to promoting and conducting educational, charitable, religious and social welfare works

Faith Formation: The Faith Formation Ministry strives to enrich and challenge the lives of our adults, young people and children.

Men's Group: The Men's Group is a committed group of men who recognize their need for God's help and who exist to support, strengthen and maximize the spiritual growth of their fellow Catholic men.

Prayer Chain: The Prayer Chain is composed of many parishioners who offer up intercessory prayer for those in need.

Pro-Life and Family Concerns: This ministry focuses on fostering a Culture of Life and Civilization of Love that affirms the dignity of all human life and supports women who are struggling as a result of an unplanned or untimely pregnancy, as well as women in need of healing from a previous abortion procedure.

RCIA: The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults, or RCIA, is a communal process for formal initiation of new members into the Catholic Church.

Women of Faith: Women of Faith is a ministry designed to bring women of all ages and life experiences together to grow spiritually, understanding our sacred call as women while deepening our relationships with one another and our community.

Women's Bible Study Group: The Women's Bible Study Group participates in various biblically based study programs presented by renowned theologians.

Women's Society: Members of the Women's Society seek to encourage the spiritual development of one another, the parish, and the community through their cooperative activities, friendships, and fellowship within the Society.

Liturgical Ministries

Lectors (Readers): The reader proclaims the readings at Mass, reads the prayers of the faithful if no deacon is present, and reads the announcements.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Acolytes: Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion assist the priest and deacon by distributing the sacred Body and Blood of Christ during Mass. It is the acolyte's responsibility to prepare the altar and the sacred vessels and, if necessary, distribute the Eucharist to the faithful as an extraordinary minister.

Ushers and Greeters: This ministry serves as the face of God, welcoming all to His house at Mass. They welcome parishioners, take up the offertory collection, coordinate reserved seating, direct the Faithful as they go to receive Communion, and hand out bulletins after Mass.

Music Ministry: Our Music Ministry is composed of any musician or singer who is willing to make a joyful noise to the Lord by leading the congregation deeper into prayer and encouraging the musical participation of everyone present.
