Worship

Altar Servers: assist the priests and deacons during the Mass or liturgical service. Boys and girls 4th grade and older; young adults, married couples and family groupings of parents and their children are invited to serve at the altar.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion: Assist priest and deacon in distributing the Body of Christ and the Precious Blood.

Lectors: A person with the talent of proclaiming clearly and intelligibly the Holy Scripture in the celebration of the Eucharist and other liturgies where the word of God is proclaimed.

Music/Cantor: Singers and musicians sing and play at weekend Masses and for special occasions.

Ushers/Greeters: Assist in seating parishioners at mass; take up collection and distribute bulletins before and after Mass; welcome/facilitate physical needs of parishioners.

Liturgy Committee: Assist the priest in planning and organizing engaging liturgies according to the yearly liturgical calendar that help to draw our parishioners into a deeper love and worship.

Sacristans: Set up for our Liturgical Celebrations and care for the sacred vessels and other items used in our Liturgies.

Décor Team: Design visually appropriate and engaging environments that help worshipers to enter more deeply into an encounter with Christ in the liturgy.

Prayer and Worship Team: Help to create and lead prayer and worship opportunities for our parish family outside of the regularly scheduled Masses.

Money Counters: Assist in counting and recording the weekend collections.

Faith Formation

Sunday PSR Catechist: Engage children in prayer and activities to help them begin developing a relationship with Jesus Christ and to learn to live as a Catholic Christian. PSR Sessions are on Sunday mornings 9:30am-10:45am.

Sunday PSR Aide: Assist PSR catechists with classroom management and activities. Open to high school students, as well as adults of all ages.

Sunday Children's Liturgy of the Word: During the Scripture readings and homily at Sunday Mass, children in kindergarten through 6th grade hear the Word of God at an age-appropriate level. Adults are needed to lead and assist in proclaiming the Word and engage the children in faith-filled activities.

CORE Youth Ministry Team Member: CORE team members help our teens grades 7-12 to encounter Christ in an engaging, welcoming and safe environment where they can grow to be the disciple God created them to be. There are different gifts to offer our youth ministries: teaching, environment preparation, technology, prayer, snack and food assistance, and just hanging out and being a positive presence for our teens to get to know.

Parish Life

Pastoral Care for Sick and Homebound: Assists the pastor and Church community respond to the spiritual, emotional, psychological, social and practical needs of parishioners who cannot take part in the life of the parish due to age, illness or loss.

Pastoral Council: Advise the pastor on parish needs and strategies that help our parish family to grow closer to God and to serve our community as the Body of Christ.

Finance Council: Consult and advise with the Pastor in the area of finance and budgets.

Hospitality Ministry: Help plan and execute opportunities for parishioners to gather in fellowship and food, i.e. – coffee and donuts, cook outs, etc...

Funeral Luncheon Committee: Help coordinate volunteers, food, and hospitality for funeral luncheons.

Building & Grounds Committee: Prioritizes our parish maintenance needs, assist in finding parishioner help, and prepares for the future.

Healing Ministries

Meals to Heal: Offering to cook or deliver meals to those who are going through a healing time and in need.

Caregiver Relief: Offering to sit with a person being cared for so that their caregiver can run to the store, go to Mass, go get a cup of coffee, etc...

Prayer Chain: Pray for and with individuals who ask for prayers from our faith community.

Community

Caring Community: Caring Community is an ecumenical group of individuals from several community churches that offers food and monetary assistance to local individuals and families in need.
