## From the Pastor

### *Series on the Mass, Part 22: The Mass and the Missal*

Before we proceed further, it might be useful to discuss the order of missals used by the faithful. The missal is generally divided into three parts: the Ordinary of the Mass, the Temporal Cycle and the Sanctoral Cycle. The Ordinary of the Mass is usually located in the central part of the missal, since this section is used the most at every Mass and its location is a convenient place to hold the missal open. The Temporal part is located in the front of the missal and begins with Advent going through the liturgical year to the last Sunday after Pentecost. The Sanctoral part is in the last half of the missal and is further broken down into the Common Masses of the Saints followed by the Proper Masses of the Saints. The first Mass of a saint in this section is usually November 29th, the Vigil of St. Andrew. The reason for this date is that it approximately corresponds to the First Sunday of Advent. It is good to be familiar with your missal and all the various parts and prayers so that you can make effective use of it as you assist at the Sacrifice of the Mass.

The Mass is the making-present-again of the sacrifice of our Savior in an un-bloody manner. This aspect of sacrifice will be very evident in going through the prayers of the Offertory, which is, in fact, the first element of a sacrifice. The offering of the sacrifice to God precedes the sacrifice itself, which takes place during the Canon, followed by communication in the sacrifice with the reception of Holy Communion. The elements of a sacrifice can be seen by answering the questions: who, what, to whom, and why. The "who" is Jesus Christ because He is the High Priest chosen by the Father to offer the sacrifice. The "what" is Christ Himself, the *Hostiam Immaculatam*, the spotless Victim, represented by the white host. "To whom" the sacrifice is offered is the Father. This is brought out in the first prayer of the Offertory as the host is being raised: *Suscipe Sancte Pater*, "Receive O Holy Father, almighty and eternal God, this spotless host..." The answer to why the sacrifice is offered is that it is offered for the glorification of the Father and the expiation of man's sins. All these elements are made clear in the prayers of the Offertory.
