

Fr. Kevin O'Neill, FSSP

Fr. Kevin O'Neill was ordained to the Sacred Priesthood by Bishop Fabian Bruskewitz in Lincoln, Nebraska on May 19, 2012, along with four other priests, including Fr. Kenneth Walker, a previous visitor of our parish.

He served at Holy Family Catholic Church in Dayton, Ohio for four months before his priestly ordination, and returned there for his First Mass. He was Parochial Vicar at St. Stephen the Martyr but was recently assigned to the newly established FSSP Apostolate in El Paso, Texas. This apostolate will begin in August at the Immaculate Conception Church in downtown El Paso.

Fr. O'Neill came to Texas on June 6, 2014, to officiate the Nuptial Mass of Eduardo Araujo, a friend and member of Regina Caeli Parish. The Mass was held at Holy Rosary Church in Houston. He celebrated the High Mass at our parish on Pentecost Sunday, June 8, and left for El Paso the next day.

Prior to this visit, Fr. O'Neill had never been to Texas. He looks forward to his new assignment and assisting the pastor in setting up the apostolate.
