

Fr. Michael Passo, FSSP

Born and raised in Omaha, Nebraska, Fr. Passo had both a parochial school education and home-schooling. As a teenager, he enrolled in the local high school for the sports program, but was disillusioned by the secular morals and concerned for his classmates. The idea of a priestly vocation began to take form in his mind.

He did not immediately answer the call. He entered college and began preparing for a medical career. In his senior year, he traveled to Mexico to serve with the Missionary Fathers of Mother Theresa, and it was there that he seriously began to consider the call to the priesthood.

When he entered the FSSP seminary in Nebraska, he was still unsure if he might return to a medical career. The peace he felt once in the seminary made it clear to him that he was where God wanted him. He was ordained a priest on June 1, 2013, and was assigned to the FSSP mission in Columbia, where he currently serves.

Fr. Passo has a sister who entered the Poor Clare Monastery in Roswell, New Mexico when he was six, and an older brother who is also a Fraternity priest. His twin brother is a member of Regina Caeli Parish.
