

Public Liturgies Suspended

March 22, 2020

In concern for human life, which is a precious gift from God, and in obedience to the Cardinal, we will follow his requests as listed in his Message to the Faithful, dated March 17, 2020, which is included in this bulletin. He is requesting the following:

- All public liturgies are suspended as of Wednesday, March 18, until further notice.
- Baptisms and home visits will be postponed, except in the case of emergencies.
- No Funeral Masses, but prayers at the grave sites of the deceased will be offered. Memorial Masses may be scheduled once the suspension of public liturgy is lifted.
- Men's and women's recollections, group meetings, Fish Fry Fridays and all other parish activities are cancelled until further notice.

Regina Caeli Parish will be open daily for private prayer from 7:30 a.m. until 7:30 p.m.

Confessions will be heard every day from 7:30 a.m. until 8:30 a.m. or until the line is gone. Confessions will also be heard Monday through Friday, from 6:30 p.m. until 7:30 p.m.

Please keep the line inside the chapel to a few penitents at a time to avoid a crowded area at the back of the chapel. Others can wait outside or stay clear of each other in the chapel until the line for confession goes down.

Please pray daily the Prayer in Times of Epidemics that our present situation be shortened. God is merciful and hears our prayers. He shall carry us through.
