

Religion

- I know that a sacrament is a special celebration of God's love.
- I know that Baptism is a gift from God.
- I know that at Baptism one becomes a member of God's family, the Church.
- I know that Jesus came to show God's love to all people.
- I know that Jesus wants all people to love God and love one another.
- I know that Jesus shows everyone how to love.
- I can identify a disciple as someone who follows Jesus Christ.
- I know that Jesus prayed and showed his disciples how to pray.

Language Arts

- I can recognize common types of texts (e.g. storybooks, poems).
- I can decode (sound out) simple CVC words (consonant-vowel-consonant).
- I can read high-frequency words by sight (popcorn words).
- I can actively engage in small and large group reading activities with purpose and understanding.
- I can follow agreed-upon rules for discussions (e.g. listening to others and taking turns speaking about the topics and texts under discussion).
- I can speak audibly and express thoughts, feelings, and ideas clearly.
- I can write my letters correctly. (Manuscript Writing)
- I can write my first name and last name correctly (Manuscript Writing)
- I can continue a conversation through multiple exchanges.

Math

- I can use 1:1 correspondence when counting.
- I can write numbers 0-20.
- I can count to answer "how many" questions about 0-20 objects and count out that many objects.
- I can represent addition and subtraction with objects, fingers, mental images, drawings, etc.
- I can solve addition and subtraction word problems within 10 by using objects or drawings to represent the problem.
- I understand that addition is putting together and adding to and subtraction is taking apart and taking from.

Science
