A SUMMER NOTE

Last year, on the Sunday I arrived, one of my first messages was about "money." I hope I've redeemed myself in the intervening year. As a result of my appeal, we had a successful campaign: "Paint the Church, Meet the Match." With a generous match we raised over \$40,000 to paint the exterior of the church for a better price than expected and as a result do some much-needed work in the rectory.

There are always needs on a property with four buildings and of course we try and raise funds to meet them. You may have noticed that lighting in the church is a recurring problem. The current lights are hot, the bulbs are expensive, perilous to replace, not very long-lasting and they use lots of energy. The Parish Finance Council has identified a program to replace them with lighting which is everything the current system is not and which promises to reduce energy use and cost by as much as 60 percent.

In the near future we will outline this and other needs in more detail. We hope that you will be able to help in another brief campaign and trust that as you have in the past, you will respond generously.
