MASS GUIDELINES

The Sacrament of

Baptism

"Holy Baptism is the basis of the whole Christian life, the gateway to life in the Spirit and the door which gives access to the other sacraments. Through Baptism we are freed from sin and reborn as sons of God; we become members of Christ, are incorporated into the Church and made sharers in her mission: "Baptism is the sacrament of regeneration through water in the word." - CCC 1213

**In general those wishing to have a child (under age 7) baptized here need to be registered, active members of St. Mary Catholic Church, Mt. Angel for at least six months prior to Baptism.*

**Parents and Godparent(s) must attend Baptismal Prep classes prior to setting a Baptism date, unless excused by the pastor.*

**Godparent(s) must be Baptized, Confirmed, and practicing Catholics without any impediments. A letter stating such from the godparents' parish (if not from St. Mary's) should be submitted.*

**The birth certificate of the child must also be submitted*

Message from the Pastor:

Changes are a comin'...

Many of you have heard the rumors by now, ...changes are coming to St. Mary Catholic Church. In early January of 2021, **FATHER RALPH RECKER, OSB**, will become Pastor of St. Mary's. In January, I will have completed 18 1/2 years of priestly ministry here and a change will be good for the parish.

Fr. Ralph was born on July 2, 1961 to Ralph and Irene Recker of New Cleveland, Ohio. He is the youngest of twelve children. His brother, Fr. Odo is also a monk of Mount Angel Abbey. He graduated from Miller City High School in 1979 and St. Meinrad College in 1983. He spent most of the next twenty years in San Antonio, Texas working for Valero Corporation as a retail manager. In 2003, he joined Mount Angel Abbey and professed vows in 2004. He was ordained a priest on June 27, 2009, and became a Formation Director and Director of Student Services in the Seminary, a position he held until July of this year, when Abbot Jeremy reassigned him to become the next Pastor of St. Mary Parish in Mt. Angel.



Over the past three and a half years, Abbot Jeremy has been meeting and speaking with me about transitioning and preparing for a new model of priestly ministry here at St. Mary's. The recommendations of the task force from the Abbey, along with consultations and recommendations from the Finance Council (which advises me also in issues of personnel) and with Archbishop Sample—all these have gone into defining and structuring this position as one which is complementary to that of the pastor.

Some months ago, I shared with you and the parish the basic outline of the position in one of my bulletin columns. The following comes from the introduction to the job description for the **PARISH COORDINATOR**:

The Parish Coordinator works with and is under the supervision of the Pastor of St. Mary Catholic Church, Mt. Angel. He works with the Pastor and assisting priests, serving as day-to-day coordinator of St. Mary's and Holy Rosary, directing the various aspects of the operations.

Interacting frequently throughout the week with the Pastor and implementing the purpose and vision of the parish, the Coordinator is responsible for the day-to-day management of parish operations. As the Pastor's operations manager, this position supervises and manages parish staff in order to ensure that the worship, education, ministry and service to parishioners happens in a consistent, methodical and collaborative manner.

I am very pleased and happy to announce that **MARK DOL** accepted the newly created position of **PARISH COORDINATOR** at St. Mary Catholic Church. He began his job on August 1, 2020. Please join me in welcoming Mark Dol to St. Mary's. I am very grateful to him for accepting this new and challenging assignment at St. Mary's.

By profession, Mark trained as a Chef in a small boutique restaurant in his native homeland of New Zealand. He then joined the Institute for World Evangelization - ICPE Mission, a Catholic Lay Missionary



Organization. During a 7-year break period when his son started school, Mark returned to the Hospitality industry. Returning with his family to full-time missionary life, Mark directed the ICPE Mission Community in Germany. After five years he was asked to come out to Oregon to work for the ICPE Mission. Mark served as Youth Minister for the Santiam Vicariate for 6 years before joining the FBYC in Fall 2015. He brings with him a multitude of skills. Mark is married to Patricia; they met and married in Germany while serving with the ICPE Mission there. They live in Sublimity. They have a grown son, Joshua who is presently serving in the U S Air Force.
