

# St. Mary's 2021-22 Faith Formation

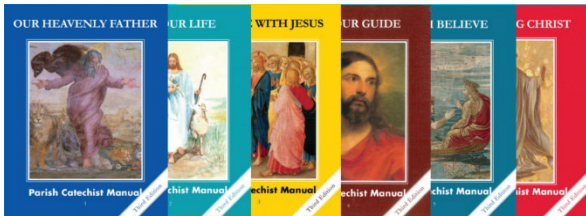
## Learning Options

It is time to register for the 2021-22 Faith Formation year! This includes Family Catechesis, K- 6 Religious Education, Jr. High & High School Youth Ministry, and Sacramental Preparation for Reconciliation, Eucharist, and Confirmation (a 2-year program).

### WEDNESDAY Age-Level Classes

**Students will meet in age-level groups every other Wednesday from 6:30-7:50pm (8pm for Jr. High & High School).**

K-6 gather in the church for prayer and then go to their grade classroom. Catechist will use the Faith and Life series for instruction and activities. Each week, even when not meeting in-person, children will have Chapter work that will reinforce what was taught in class and will get parents involved in the



religious education of their child.

Jr. High & High School groups will cover various topics and also have activities/projects to do on "OFF" Wednesdays.

### SUNDAY Family Catechesis.

**Learn and grow together as a family. Primarily the 1<sup>st</sup> and last Sunday of each month, the whole family will meet from 11:20am-12:20pm (English) or 1:40-2:40pm (Spanish).** The 1<sup>st</sup> class of each month will introduce a theme, provide teachings & materials, and then families will be sent home with knowledge and resources to use & practice before the 2<sup>nd</sup> monthly meeting, when families will share, and the material will take on "living flesh".

Studies tell us that parental involvement in the faith-life of their child is by far the most important element in ensuring that a child develops into a practicing Christian. This program will empower parents to take the lead in leading their children to heaven.

### Sacramental Preparation Classes

Reconciliation, Eucharist, and Confirmation (Year 1 & Year 2)



Reconciliation, Eucharist (1<sup>st</sup> Communion), and Confirmation - 1<sup>st</sup> Year will meet the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday of each month from 6:30-8pm. Confirmation - 2<sup>nd</sup> Year will meet every other Wednesday from 6:30-8pm. (Alternating between Age-Level Classes.)

- \* Parents accompany Reconciliation & Eucharist students each month.
- \* Confirmation is a 2-year program starting the Freshman year.
