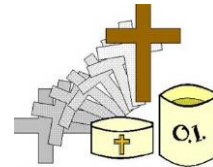

Sacrament of Anointing

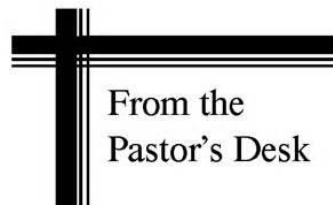

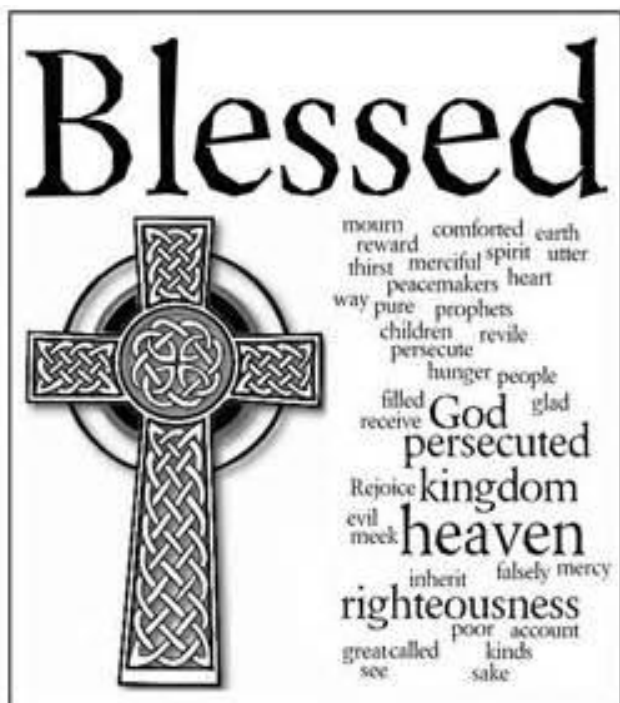

Religious Education News

Review of the 2015-2016 Religious Education School Year



Thanks to everyone that helped with this year's Religious Education program. It was a year unlike any other. Classes started late due to the repairs that were made on the Parish Center, and there was a lot of cleaning that had to take place before the start of classes. The RE Team stepped up to the plate as usual, and volunteers cleaned every inch of the Parish Center during the day and on week-ends to prepare the classrooms for the students. The first day of class was also the start of the Thanksgiving Food Drive!

525 students registered for RE for the 2015-2016 school year. The students attended classes on Sunday, Tuesday or Wednesday, collected food for the Thanksgiving food drive, prepared baskets for Thanksgiving, re-told the Christmas story during the Pageant at the Children's Christmas Eve Mass, collected \$406.63 during "*Souper Bowl of Caring*" to assist needy families in our parish, filled Lenten Sacrifice boxes with \$388.69 which was donated to the St. Vincent De Paul Society at St. Martin of Tours, hosted 2 Easter Egg hunts and learned to be merciful and Christ-like during these activities.

68 of these students completed their two-year preparation for Confirmation, which included attending a retreat. Two Confirmation retreats were offered: one for the 8th graders and one for the High School. These students also completed 25 hours of service to Family, Community and Church, submitted 6 homily reports, a saint report and wrote letters to Fr. Orosco and Msgr. Milam Joseph indicating their desire to be confirmed.

104 students completed their second year of preparation and made their *First Reconciliation and First Communion*.

32 High School students were registered for the Sunday morning RE class. These students have completed their Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Holy Eucharist, and Confirmation. Their curriculum focuses on *Theology of the Body* and advanced formation in the Catholic Faith. Several of these students participated in a retreat called "*Ablaze*", which is a Eucharistic centered retreat. The Catechists and additional chaperones drove the students to and from the retreat at St. Monica's Parish in Dallas starting on Friday and ending on Sunday.

There are 80 adults and 10 High School Aides that currently comprise the Religious Education Team. This year Lois LaDay, the longest tenured Catechist, received the Bishop's Award. Without this group there would be no Religious Education program at St. John the Apostle. This group is dedicated to bringing Christ to the kids at St. John's and helping them along their journey of faith. They are passionate about their work, several teach on two classes, and are always willing to help with extra projects. The adults have all completed the screening for Safe Environment and most have been involved with the Religious Education program for at least 5 years. Ten of the adults were students here at St. John's and have chosen to teach here as adults. This group of adults and teens are absolutely the best and I am grateful for the energy and enthusiasm that they bring to this program. We are looking forward to the 2016-2017 school year.
