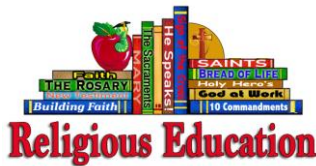

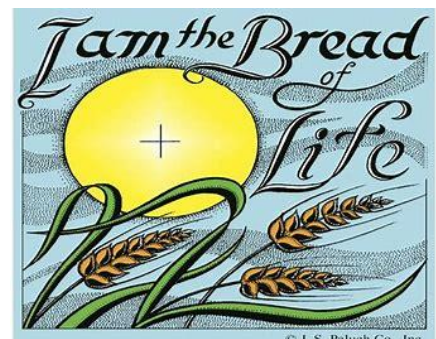
Eighteenth Week in Ordinary Time

On the 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time, we are in the second of five Sunday gospels from the 6th chapter of John's gospel and the Bread of Life readings. Jesus tells the crowd, "Do not work for food that perishes but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you."

Monday is the **Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord**, with its own special readings. Wednesday is the **Memorial of Saint Dominic**. Friday is the **Feast of Saint Lawrence**, deacon and martyr, with special readings. Saturday is the **Memorial of Saint Clare**.

This week we complete our readings from the **Book of the Prophet Jeremiah**. Friday and Saturday have the consoling readings from the **Prophet Nahum** and the **Prophet Habakkuk**, "the vision still has its time."

In **Matthew's Gospel** this week we hear some marvelous words about faith and discipleship. Monday is **Matthew's** version of the Miracle of the loaves and fishes. On Tuesday there is the choice between two gospels: Jesus comes to his disciples across the water in a storm, and invites Peter to come to him, across the water; when Peter comes he takes his eyes off Jesus and goes down. In the other Gospel option, the Pharisee asks why Jesus' disciples don't follow the dietary laws and Jesus says, "It is not what enters one's mouth that defiles the man; but what comes out of the mouth is what defiles one." In contrast to the lack of faith of the religious leaders, on Wednesday Jesus delights in the faith and trust of a non-Jew, a woman in the enemy Gentile territory to the north. Thursday Peter recognizes Jesus as the Son of Man and seems to doubt him at the same time. Jesus sums up our discipleship wonderfully: "*Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. What profit would there be for one to gain the whole world and forfeit his life? Or what can one give in exchange for his life?*" The disciples wonder why they could not drive out a demon from a boy, Jesus answers, "Because of your little faith." Faith "the size of a mustard seed" is enough.
