Always, always, in spite of weakness, falls and shortcomings of every kind, **Jesus, help me** and never forsake me.

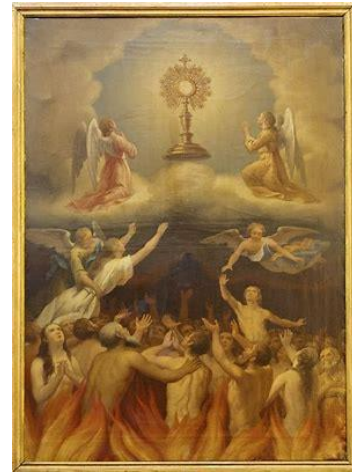

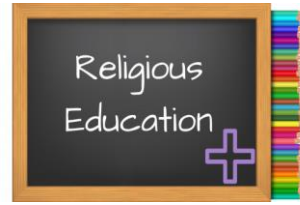
