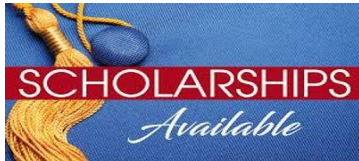

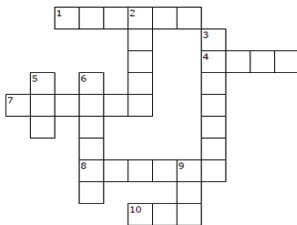

## Thirteenth Week in Ordinary Time



On the **Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**, we hear the wonderful story of the healing of Jairus' daughter. In the middle of that story is the beautiful story of the healing of the woman with a hemorrhage. He said to her, 'Daughter, your faith has saved you. Go in peace and be cured of your affliction.'" Jesus tells Jairus, "Do not be afraid; just have faith." When the girl was healed the people "were utterly astounded."

Monday is the **Memorial of Saint Irenaeus, Bishop and Martyr**. Tuesday is the **Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles**. Saturday is the **Feast of Saint Thomas, Apostle**.

The first readings this week are from the **Book of Genesis**. We follow the story of Abraham and his son Isaac.

**Matthew's Gospel** takes us through several stories about Jesus' ministry. We begin as Jesus demonstrates that following him requires a radical change in life: "Follow me, and let the dead bury their dead." Jesus calms the storm at sea. Then he drives demons out of two men living among the tombs. When a paralyzed man is brought to him, Jesus has compassion on the man and forgives his sins, which causes a controversy. Jesus then heals the man's paralysis. He calls Matthew to leave his customs post and follow him, and the many tax collectors and sinners who come to have dinner with Jesus cause a controversy with the religious leaders. "Those who are well do not need a physician, but the sick do. Go and learn the meaning of the words, I desire mercy, not sacrifice. I did not come to call the righteous but sinners."

**“NO TEMAS,  
BASTA QUE TENGAS FE”**



En el evangelio de este domingo se manifiesta el poder de Jesús sobre la enfermedad y la muerte: sana a la mujer que padecía flujo de sangre y devuelve la vida a la hija de Jairo.

- Ya el libro de la Sabiduría nos dice que “Dios no hizo la muerte, ni se recrea en la destrucción de los vivientes”, y que “por envidia del diablo entró la muerte en el mundo”.
- Hubo personas que se rieron de Jesús cuando les dijo que la niña dormía; pero él sabía lo que iba a hacer, y le devolvió la vida.
- Por su parte, la mujer que padecía flujo de sangre, a quien desde hacía doce años se le estaba yendo la vida poco a poco, tuvo la confianza y el valor de acercarse a Jesús, y alcanzó de él la tan anhelada salud: “Hija, tu fe te ha curado. Vete en paz y queda sana de tu enfermedad”.
- Y es que Jesús, verdadero Dios y verdadero hombre, es “el camino, la verdad y la vida” (Jn 14, 6).
