SCHOOL YEAR NEWS 2015

St. Anthony School (Grades PK-6 and St. Joseph Regional Jr. High School) (Grades 7-8) have an opening immediately for a school nurse. Position is 25 hours/week, 9am-2pm. Responsibilities include caring for students daily needs, medication administration, communicating with parents and school staff, health screenings, and compliance with state immunization requirements. Peeking into... Grade 2

The second grade class is busy building simple machines. The students have built a lever, a pulley, a pendulum and an incline plane. Working in four teams with the support of our school volunteers, the children are designing a plan using all four machines and in one continuous motion, they can capture their dinosaur. In social studies and reading each student has chosen a biography to read about a famous person. The students are writing "Who Am I?" riddles. Wearing costumes to enhance their presentation, the students will present their reports in the gym on Feb. 18th. to see how many of the older students can identify these famous individuals. In math we have conquered the concept of regrouping with addition and subtraction. This important skill will help the students as they begin their unit on money and practice using coins in our class store. The students are also preparing to make the Sacrament of Reconciliation soon. We have learned the Prayer of Sorrow and understand the steps of this important sacrament. The children who are parishioners at our parish also attend classes each Sunday morning to strengthen their knowledge and understanding of this sacrament and their faith.

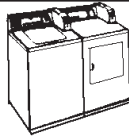
