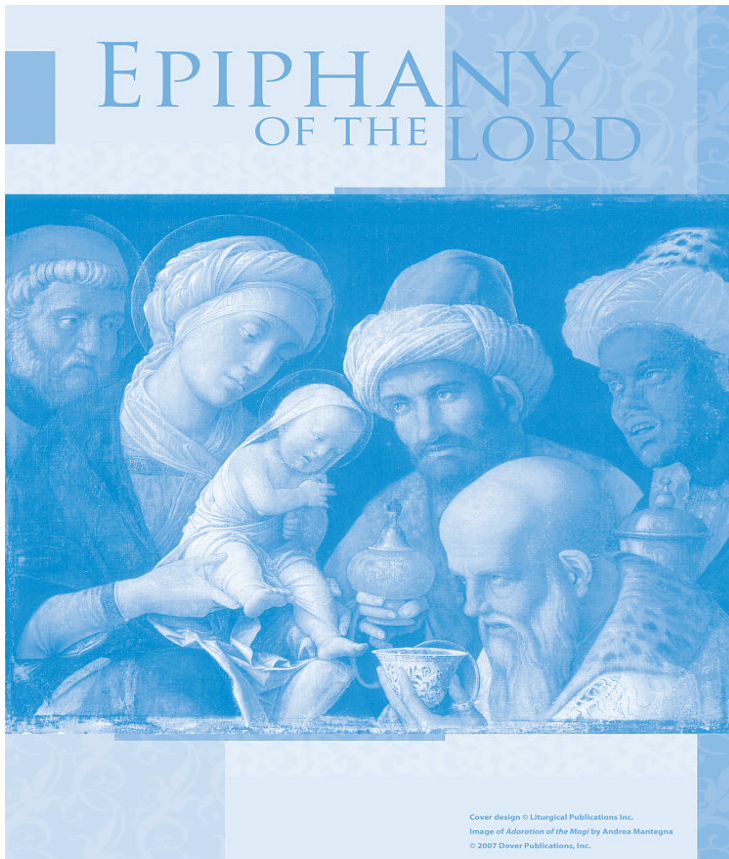

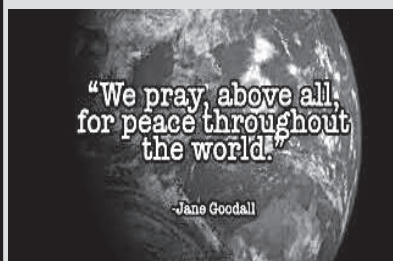


NORTHEAST CATHOLIC COLLEGE

Presidential Scholarship is a full-tuition scholarship. This highly competitive four-year scholarship is awarded to an incoming freshman who has written a compelling essay demonstrating his or her reading of a papal encyclical by Pope St. John Paul II or Benedict XVI. The essay should exhibit careful reflection upon the meaning of the encyclical for Catholics at the beginning of the twenty-first century. The student's essay must be five to seven pages in length, double-spaced, with one-inch margins. Recipients of the college's Presidential Scholarship must maintain a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.4 during their four years and must participate in the college's Honors Program. Finalist for the Scholarship will have a phone interview to determine the winner.

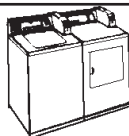
