Michael (Mike) is a 60+ year young man. The first child of Yvon & June Brunette, Mike grew up on Manchester's West side, across the street from St. Peter's Orphanage. His family was very involved with the welfare of the orphans, and Mike developed his sense of community (and specifically Church) service in his early years. The Brunette family (Yvon, his brother Francis, and their Dad Romeo) started a family laundry business that continues today under the name of Laundry Equipment Corp. Mike and two of his sons are continuing the family business. Mike's family were parishioners of St. Patrick parish and Mike graduated from the parish school. In his junior year at Trinity High School, Mike met the love of his life, Therese (Terri) Huard. In 1975 they wed at St. George parish, Terri's home parish. Around this time, Mike, already a Boy Scout leader began serving in various parish ministries and administrative roles.

The next few years saw Mike & Terri's family grow, with the addition of Chris (1977), Dave (1979) and Steve (1981). The Children grew and began attending St. Anthony School. Because of the children's frequent mass attendance at St. Anthony parish, and the family having moved to Southeast Manchester, the family left St. George and registered at St. Anthony. Unable to sit still when "things needed doing", Mike was soon fully immersed in volunteer roles at his new parish.

Mike is a graduate of the original class of the Diocese's Lay Minister Formation program, "Called to Servant Leadership", and among other roles, serves as the Chair of the Pastoral Council.

Peeking into Grade 5

The fifth graders have been very busy since school started. They have learned about characters, settings, problems, events, and solutions in the stories they have read. They have also worked on writing summaries for the stories as well. In writing, the students wrote poems about the fall or school. They wrote personal narratives about what they had done on their summer vacations. They have also learned about writing and acting in a play since they created the skits they performed on Grandparents' Day, about how they see life here at St. Anthony School. The students also learned about the parts of speech, capitalization rules, punctuation rules, and types of sentences. In science, the fifth graders learned how changing variables can produce different results by experimenting with growing mold on bread in different conditions. They tested growing mold by adding more water to the bread. The students were able to grow lots of mold. They loved this "gross" experiment! They have also been learning about space and observing the moon and the stars at night. They recently created a Venn diagram comparing the moon and the Earth. These are just some of the many things that the fifth graders have been busy doing since school started!

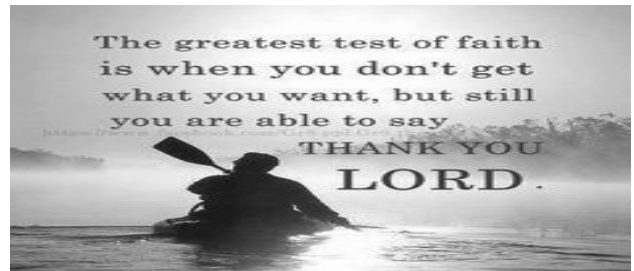
