NORTHEAST CATHOLIC COLLEGE

Once again, NCC in Warner, NH is pleased to announce the dates for its Summer Program for high school students. The Collegiate Summer Program offers participants the opportunity to study theology, philosophy, literature and political science. During the summer program, students also attend daily Mass and enjoy sports, socials and day trips including hiking and canoeing. The program is for students who will be entering their sophomore, junior or senior year of high school in the fall of 2017. It is also open to students who have just graduated high school. The Collegiate Summer Program is a two-week session that runs from Sunday, July 23–Saturday, August 5, 2017.

INTENSIVE INTRODUCTION TO ATTIC GREEK COURSE AT NORTHEAST CATHOLIC COLLEGE

The importance of learning Greek cannot be overstated. Western literature, drama, philosophy, political systems, all begin in Classical Athens and can be best understood when read in the original. Additionally, learning Attic Greek gives students access to literature not only of the specific era, but back to the works of Homer and forward through Patristic literature to the Byzantines. This course offers students an intensive survey of Attic Greek grammar and vocabulary over three weeks, covering approximately two semesters worth of material. Additionally, students will begin translating short passages of Greek text.

The course is designed to be an introduction for students interested in the Classics who would like to move more quickly to begin translation courses, or as a resource for teachers of Classical languages such as Latin who would like to begin teaching Greek as well.

This three-week course runs from Monday, July 24 through Friday, August 11, 2017. The cost is \$450 for commute students and \$750 for residential students (room and board included). Peeking Into Grade 6

With a very successful Science Fair behind us, the 6th grade is now exploring the world of protists and fungi. The students have been collecting samples of pond water and will observe their habits, movements, and characteristics under the microscope. There have been some interesting discussions on the "good and bad" fungus in our lives and the benefits of both. We are in the middle of our unit on fractions. What a difference a year makes!!! The 6th graders have definitely become experts with the operations of fractions. Our next step is for the students to be able to shop at the mall and figure out using percents, what their marked down summer clothes will cost.

Our class has 2 great field trips this spring. Last week we traveled to Lowell Mills to experience an Ecology hands-on science lab. The students learned importance of keeping our water supply clean. We took a boat ride along the Merrimack River, testing the water quality, along with seeing how the canal system operates. In June, we will summarize our unit on oceanography by visiting the Seacoast Science Center in Rye, NH. We will go pan fishing in our salt marshes, spend a few hours tide pooling for ocean creatures along our coast, then finish with a scavenger hunt to Sandy Beach.

We will finish our school year with a 6th grade retreat organized by Father Dion and Mrs. Hind.
