On the first weekend of June we will be celebrating the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. The Eucharist is the source and summit of our Christian life, but without priests there is no Eucharist. Many of us set aside this weekend every year to celebrate the ordination and first Masses of our newly ordained priests, but with the absence of ordinations this year, we feel a more pressing need to pray for vocations! We ask every parish in the diocese to set aside time on the first weekend of June for a special time of prayer for vocations to the priesthood.

St. Anthony Parish will have a special Mass for Vocations on Saturday June 2 at 10AM. Please keep in mind this Mass does not cover your weekend obligation.

Peeking into Grade 4...

Grade 4 is working very hard on their division. The students can see that practicing daily and learning those multiplication facts has paid off! We will continue to work on our division and then move to "elapsed time." We are studying the three types of rocks, the rock cycle, and how weathering is related to erosion in Science. We just began Adverbs in Grammar. This year the 4th grade has had plenty of stories to identify figurative language. This week we are reading a Historical Fiction poem, I HAVE HEARD OF A LAND, which uses figurative language to create a mental picture of the promises and possibilities of settling the frontier in the 1800's. We are studying our state's unique symbols in New Hampshire History. We will be reviewing NH State Government before our Field Trip on May 22nd. We are looking forward to our tour of the State House and the home of Franklin Pierce. Students have worked very hard this year and I am so proud of them!
