PRAYING ON PENNACOOK ST.—BABY SAVED

Wednesday morning, Planned Parenthood had a man and a woman on duty to escort their patients inside, but that didn't stop a new sidewalk counselor from approaching a car when it reached the driveway. The couple was willing to park on the street and talk. They are from Nepal and have two daughters. The wife had taken a pregnancy test at home and didn't know how far along she was, but they were surprised and happy to meet people who were interested in helping them. They were told about the Pennacook Pregnancy Center, and never entered PP. Their baby was saved from abortion! Later a man stopped and asked where PP was, as he was there to pick someone up. He went inside and came out looking confused. Whoever he went to pick up had not shown up. Later in the day, a recent graduate from Ave Marie University joined the prayer vigil.

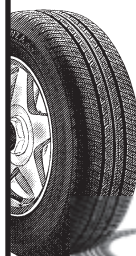
