PRAYING ON PENNACOOK STREET

Planned Parenthood applied for, and received, a parking variance from the City of Manchester. Wednesday surgical and medical abortions were scheduled at PP. One woman stopped to tell the sidewalk counselors she did an adoption with her previous pregnancy, but this time she was going to have the baby "sucked out." This young woman went back outside three times to talk to them because she was very conflicted about what to do. She was offered all kinds of help, but finally went back into PP for her appointment. That's the way it is on Pennacook Street: some people tell off the counselors, some tell them why they are aborting their baby, some say nothing, and some accept their help and continue their pregnancy. The counselors are prayerful and peaceful, and ignore the passersby who stop to pass judgement on them. It is important to have a visible presence in defense of the babies whose lives are threatened with death by their own mothers. Many people are now aware of what happens inside PP because of the people who pray on the sidewalk on Pennacook Street.
