PRAYING ON PENNACOOK STREET
 Planned Parenthood had surgical appointments scheduled for three days the week after the 4th of July. However, they only did surgical abortions on two of those days and were very busy, with the abortionist staying until at least 6pm on Wednesday. A bright yellow car parked in the lot and when the two women got out, the passenger was holding a big brown teddy bear in one hand, and blowing smoke from her e-cigarette in the other. Yes, she was old enough to smoke, but not mature enough to go into her abortion appointment without her teddy bear. Later, a couple parked on the street and as the woman walked by, the sidewalk counselors offered her information. She replied, "I'm a drug addict. I can't take care.." and her voice trailed off. Her companion asked the police officer if he could move his "new truck" into the parking lot. He said, "I'm OCD. I'm worried about getting the first scratch." When he walked by to move his truck, counselors asked why he was worried about his truck but not the baby that was being aborted. He replied that he wasn't the father, and offered some obscenities. That Friday, a small group stood on the Bridge St. bridge with a large banner that read,
"ABORTION TAKES A HUMAN LIFE"
 Many of the drivers waved and gave thumbs up signs.
