PARISH NURSE:

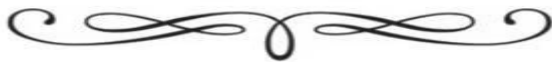
The Parish Nurse Program at St. Anthony Parish will resume on Thursday September 13th, from 9-11AM. Stop by say hi and have your blood pressure checked!
