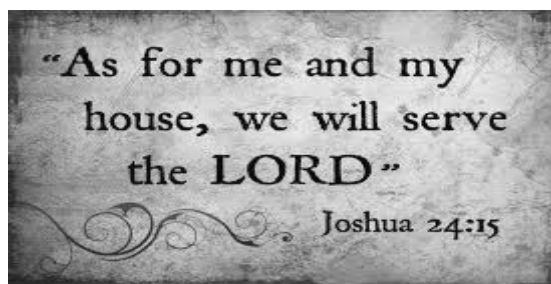

Ministry Schedule

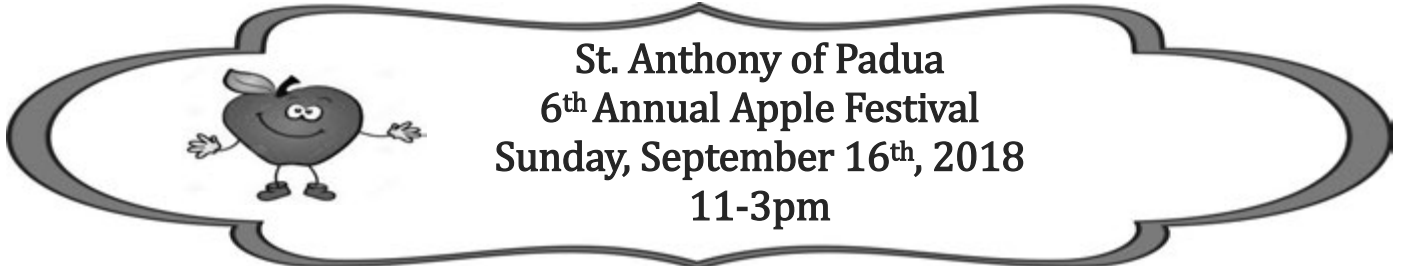
