PRAYING ON PENNACOOK STREET

While volunteers were on the sidewalk praying for women going into Planned Parenthood, the men doing renovations there walked by several times. One of the young construction workers eventually asked why they were there. He was shocked when he learned abortions were being done inside the building where he was working. A few days earlier his girlfriend told him she was pregnant. She told her mother and they decided she would have an abortion. The construction worker was very upset, and told her he would raise the baby. She refused to listen to him and said her mother told her it was better to abort the baby. He is trying to change her mind. It is very sad that a father has no say whether his baby lives or dies.

Later, there were positive responses from people traveling on Elm Street to volunteers holding a picture of a 9 week-old pre-born baby. One passerby stopped to say how much she regretted aborting three babies, and said she would return the next week to pray the rosary with the volunteers. Rev. Jeff Statz of St. Francis of Assisi Church turned his car around to bless the volunteers and pray with them. He also walked up to the Pennacook Pregnancy Center to see the office and meet the women working there.
