It has been an amazing yet busy first month of school. The children have settled into the routine and have gotten to know each other. New friendships have formed and it is often like they have known one another for years.

He will come in handy when we learn about the bones, joints, and how our body moves. Students learned the difference between a resting pulse and an active pulse through some physical exercise.
