Peeking into Grade 2...

In the Grade 2 Beehive, students began the year as scientists. As part of the curriculum, they learned about living things and what all living things need to survive. To date, they have completed 2 experiments and written 2 lab reports. The first experiment allowed these curious scientists to grow green bean plants by germinating seeds in Ziploc baggies. Once germinated, the seeds were then transferred to soil. The Dirty Shoe Experiment demonstrated the importance of hand washing as well as removing shoes once inside our homes. There were lots of reactions to the amount, color and smell of the mold students were able to grow after they wiped their shoes on a slice of bread. Next up, students are looking forward to building a short-term time capsule that will allow them to explore decomposition of living items in soil. The time-capsule will be opened in June. Stay tuned for updates as they continue their scientific journey this year!

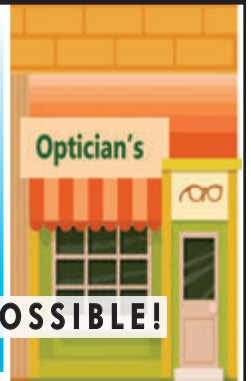
