***Advent Begins December 2<sup>nd</sup>***



*Stop and take time to focus on what really counts this time of year, to prepare for the arrival of our Lord Jesus Christ, both in the Nativity and in His Second Coming as well! During Advent, we await the celebration of Jesus's birth at Christmas while taking stock of our readiness for His return.*

*The season of Advent (from the Latin "adventus" meaning "coming") precedes Christmas. Starting with the first Sunday closest to November 30<sup>th</sup>, it marks the first season of the church's Liturgical year.*

*Pope John Paul II once remarked that he hoped that advent would be a time for us to strengthen our commitment to our Christian faith. Focusing on the Nativity as well as on the Second Coming reminds us of the timelessness of God's love, and of the importance of showing others His love in our thoughts, words, and actions.*

*Advent reminds us to give of ourselves and to be open to reflecting Christ's presence in our lives, as we think about His being born in a manger in Bethlehem to redeem us from our sins so that we may share Eternal Life with Him in Heaven!*

**PEEKING INTO KINDERGARTEN**

The Kindergarteners have been very busy! We are beginning to recognize letters and their sounds by learning special alphabet songs. We have been adding High Frequency Words to our Word Wall each week and can read, yes, READ, these words in simple take-home booklets. In math we have been concentrating on learning how to apply the words left, right, above, below, under, over, in and out. We are becoming masters at completing patterns. We can even make patterns with our bodies by repeating poses. (What must people think when they walk by???) We understand how our five senses work together to help us make good decisions. (Crossing the street may involve hearing, seeing and feeling the ground beneath us. Eating soup may involve seeing, tasting, smelling and touching the hot bowl.) We have listed reasons why we need rules in a school and laws in society. We've discussed what animals need in order to live, which includes food, water and shelter, and the environments in which they can thrive. Our favorite time of day is when we talk about the love of our Lord, Jesus Christ. We have discussed many ways to pray, and that none of them are wrong. We understand that prayer is powerful and involves being thankful.

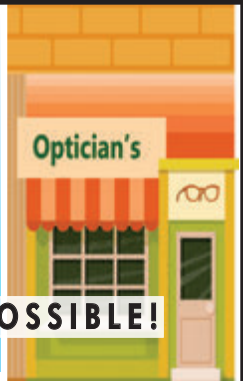
