We are making our Advent material available a week earlier this year. Hopefully you will be able to have your materials at hand for the beginning of Advent, November 29th. At the back of church you will find Advent booklets for all ages. These booklets are free to anyone who would like to pick up one or two and perhaps enhance their Advent experience. This year’s selections are:

- Additional copies of the Word Among Us, O **Come, Emmanuel** – and complete Mass w/daily meditations
- Daybreaks, *A New Light Shines* by Connie Clark, from Twenty-Third Publications
- *Now is the Time, Preparing the Way of the Lord* by Pope Francis, from All Saints Press,
- For our parish Teens (grades 7 thru 12) there is **Make way for Advent** from Creative Communications.

The children’s choices for Advent are:

- **You Will Find the Baby**, stories and activities for Pre- 3; Pre-K has stories, and coloring in **Come Lord Jesus.**
- **Look Around the Manger** with coordinating stickers is for our kindergarteners.
- Grade 1, will **Hear the Angels Sing!** – an explanation of Christmas Carols, with stickers.
- Grades 2, 3 and 4 explore **Jesus Family Tree**, with 3D Tree and stickers.
- The selection for grades 5, and 6 is **Praying the Jesse Tree**, daily readings and activity book.

The above titled booklets have been given to the children in our school. Additional booklets are at the back of church are for anyone to pick up. There also is the annual, and very popular with the children, Advent calendar. This year’s choice is **The Way in the Manger**, a manger with coordinated stickers to the readings.
