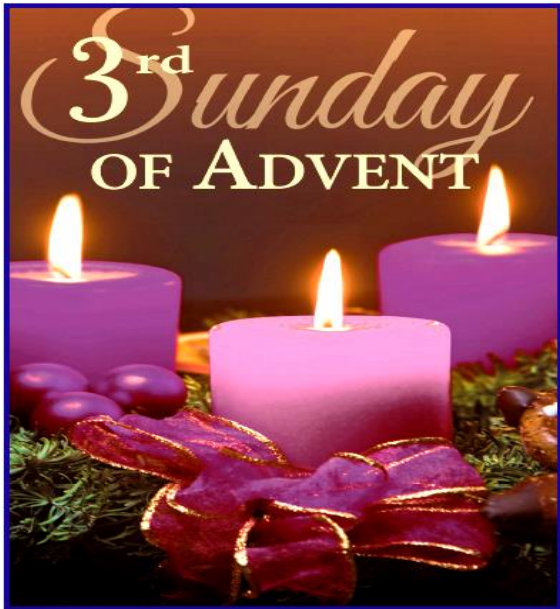

### Christmas and New Year's Mass Schedules

Due to the uncommon and unprecedented environment in which we find ourselves, the Diocese has recommended that parishioners attend one Mass at least from Christmas Eve on Thursday to the Sunday Masses on December 27<sup>th</sup>. December 27<sup>th</sup> is also the Feast of the Holy Family. If you wish to sign up for both a Christmas Mass and a weekend Mass you are free to do so.

Below are the Mass schedules for Christmas. You will need to reserve a seat for these Masses. There will be seating chart sign-up sheets at the back of church for each Mass for you to place your reservation on. The sheets are different colors with the Mass at the top right hand corner. Due to distancing guidelines for COVID, you must sign up for the Mass you wish to attend as there will only be that amount of seating available.
