**Christmas and New Year's Mass Schedules**

Due to the uncommon and unprecedented environment in which we find ourselves, the Diocese has recommended that parishioners attend one Mass at least from Christmas Eve on Thursday to the Sunday Masses on December 27<sup>th</sup>. December 27<sup>th</sup> is also the Feast of the Holy Family. If you wish to sign up for both a Christmas Mass and a weekend Mass you are free to do so.

Due to distancing guidelines for COVID, you need to reserve a seat for these Masses. There are seating/sign-up chart at the back of church for each Mass for you to place your reservation on. You must sign up for the Mass you wish to attend as there will only be that amount of seating available.
