FISH FRY ANNOUNCEMENT:

The health and safety of our students, families, parishioners, and patrons is our primary concern. With the spread of COVID-19, the Center for Disease Control (CDC) has issued a number of recommendations to inhibit the spread of COVID-19. One such recommendation is to “put distance between yourself and other people if COVID-19 is spreading in your community. This is especially important for people who are at higher risk of getting very sick.” As a result, St. Joseph’s will make the following modifications to its Lenten fish fries. Each of the following is effective immediately and until further notice.

1. Dine-in Service will be suspended.
2. Carry Out Service will be suspended.
3. Child care will be suspended.
4. Students do not need to report to work.

St. Joseph’s will continue to operate its Car Side service as usual. We will be increasing the allowable number of orders per time slot to allow more orders during each time interval. The link for online ordering is given below. The link will open at 8AM Friday morning.
